FROM ITALY

Direct flights from Italy to Almería are not available. You will need to take a connecting flight, with layovers typically occurring in Madrid or Barcelona.

Another option is to fly to Malaga, from Italy there are flights to Malaga from the following cities:

There are direct flights from Rotterdam to Almeria during summer operated by Transavia on the following days:

FROM MALAGA TO ALMERIA

BY BUS

There are buses operated by ALSA from Malaga to Almeria. There is a direct bus from Malaga airport to Almeria at 14:30 and it takes around 3 hours to arrive. The price is around 23 euros per person per way.

BY CAR

Renting a car, Almería is about two and a half hours from Málaga Airport, offering the freedom to explore around. The city isn't well connected, so having a car helps.

HOTEL RECOMENDATIONS

The bus will depart from the city center, the precise location is still to be confirmed. We strongly recommend staying in the city center for the wedding weekend. Public transport near the wedding venue is unavailable, and given the city's poorly connected nature, you will need a car to get around.

WHAT TO DO IN ALMERIA?

Almería is a unique place in southern Spain where cinematic desert landscapes meet stunning Mediterranean beaches. Known as a true cinema land, it offers a special mix of nature, history, and authenticity. It would mean a lot to welcome you here, as Almería is a deeply important part of Laura's roots.

HISTORIC & CULTURAL HIGHLIGHTS

- Alcazaba of Almería – historic fortress citadel
 - A sprawling Moorish fort from the 10th century with gardens, towers and dramatic views over the city and sea.
- Almería Cathedral (Catedral de la Encarnación)
 - A unique Renaissance–Gothic cathedral with fortress-like walls, built to guard against pirate raids.
- Museum of Almería
 - Archaeological exhibits that trace the region's prehistoric past and ancient cultures.
- Refugios de la Guerra Civil
 - Underground tunnels used in the Spanish Civil War (guided tours).
- Paseo Marítimo & Playa el zapillo
 - Lovely seaside walk and beach with some tapas/chiringuitos bar along the seafront.
- Desierto tabernas
 - The area features Europe's sole official desert, along with a cinema studio available for visits. Mini Hollywood

CABO DE GATA- NÍJAR NATURAL PARK

The Cabo de Gata-Níjar Natural Park is a protected area known for its dramatic coastal landscapes, volcanic geology and pristine beaches. It's one of Europe's most unique natural parks.
